Following the development of a proprietary digital management system released last year, which provides secure access and storage for welder qualification and testing records to industrial clients, Ready Arc is pleased to announce a new online service now available to New Brunswick's qualified welders.

Ready Arc Renew provides welders with a secure online profile to store their welding qualifications (or "tickets" as they're called) and to have their renewals processed by Ready Arc automatically, for a small fee. Renewal of welding tickets is required annually for every certified pressure welder in the province.

"Welders need valid tickets to work and companies need welders to have this covered. We have found that with no reliable reminder system in place, and only paper tickets issued (easily lost or damaged), welders can easily miss their annual expiry date while focused on working and living busy lives. Once a ticket has expired over 30 days, welders have to perform a test to reinstate their tickets. This can cost hundreds of dollars, particularly if they have to repeat the test multiple times. Our goal here is to save welders from the hassle of renewals and the stress and cost of expired tickets." - Jason Martin, Ready Arc President

Ready Arc has plans to build on the Ready Arc Renew service, providing more technology-based services for the industry and its welders, along with accommodating automatic renewals outside of New Brunswick.
